Katelyn played on the first girl's lacrosse team at her high school.






- Dean can operate just about any piece of large equipment from excavators to dump trucks to skid steers.

- Dean got to meet Tracy Lawrence on his tour bus after a concert.


 He even got his cowboy hat signed!









HOME SWEET HOME

Incorporating our faith into our home is a joyful endeavor that allows us to live a peace-filled life no matter what comes our way!




Dreams of the Future
