- getting all of the belly rubs.

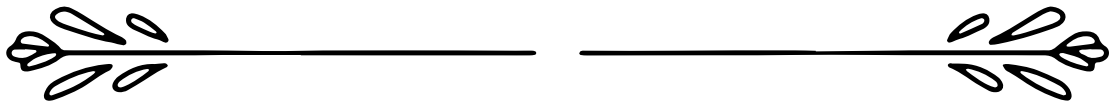
Our Home



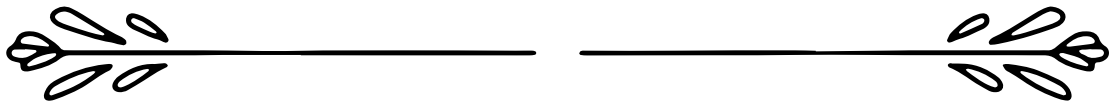

Our Family

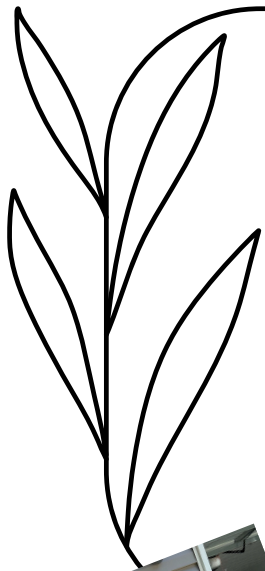

Our Team

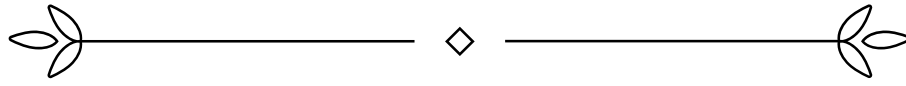

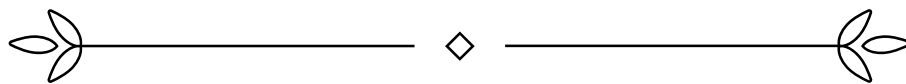
