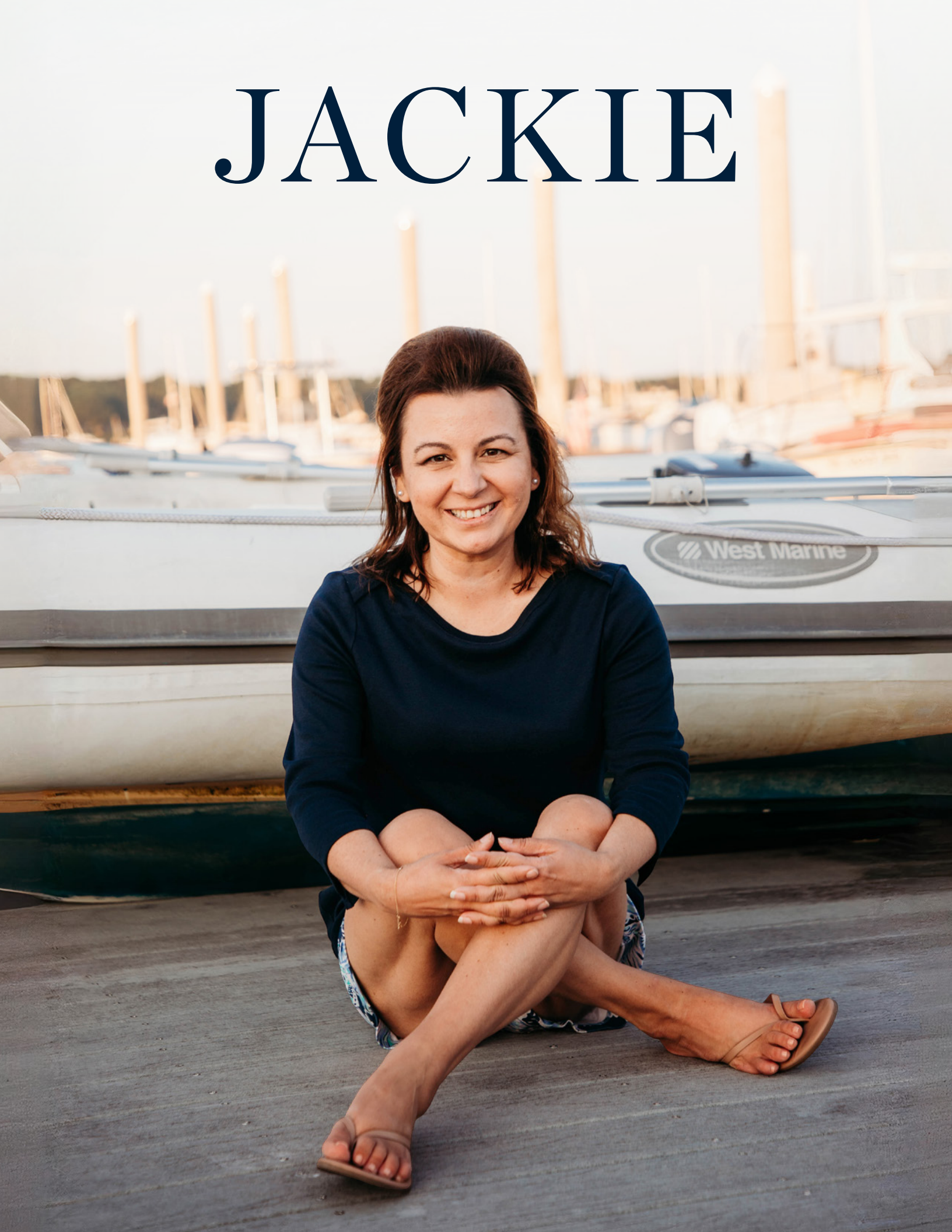

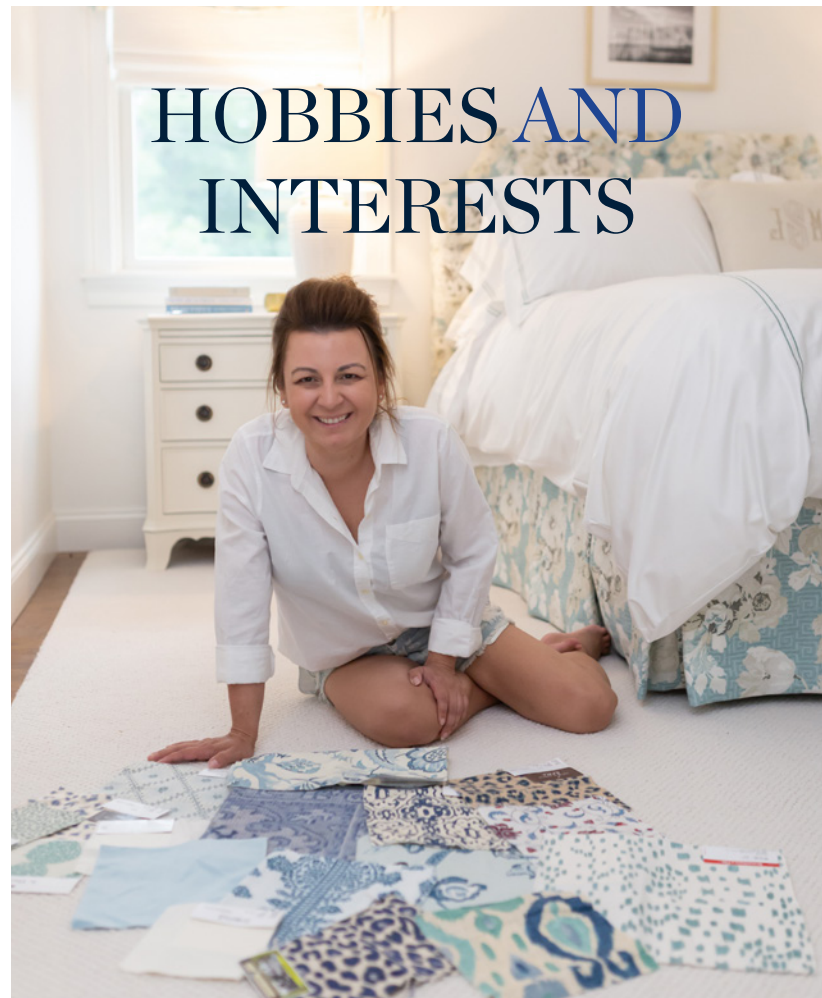
Starting and leading a non-profit wasn't easy, but on nights like this one it was a lot of fun.

### *helping others*

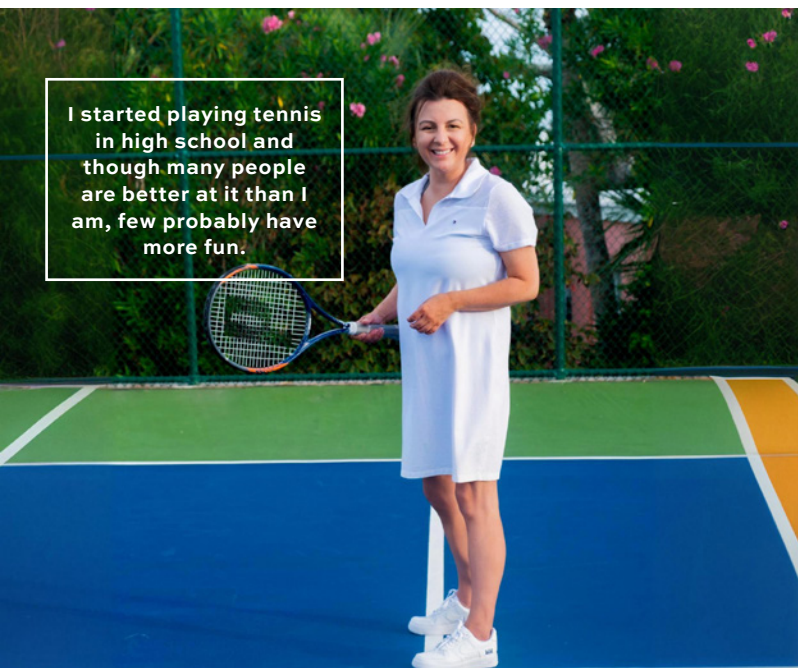

Enjoying a summer afternoon at home with my cousin Isaac.



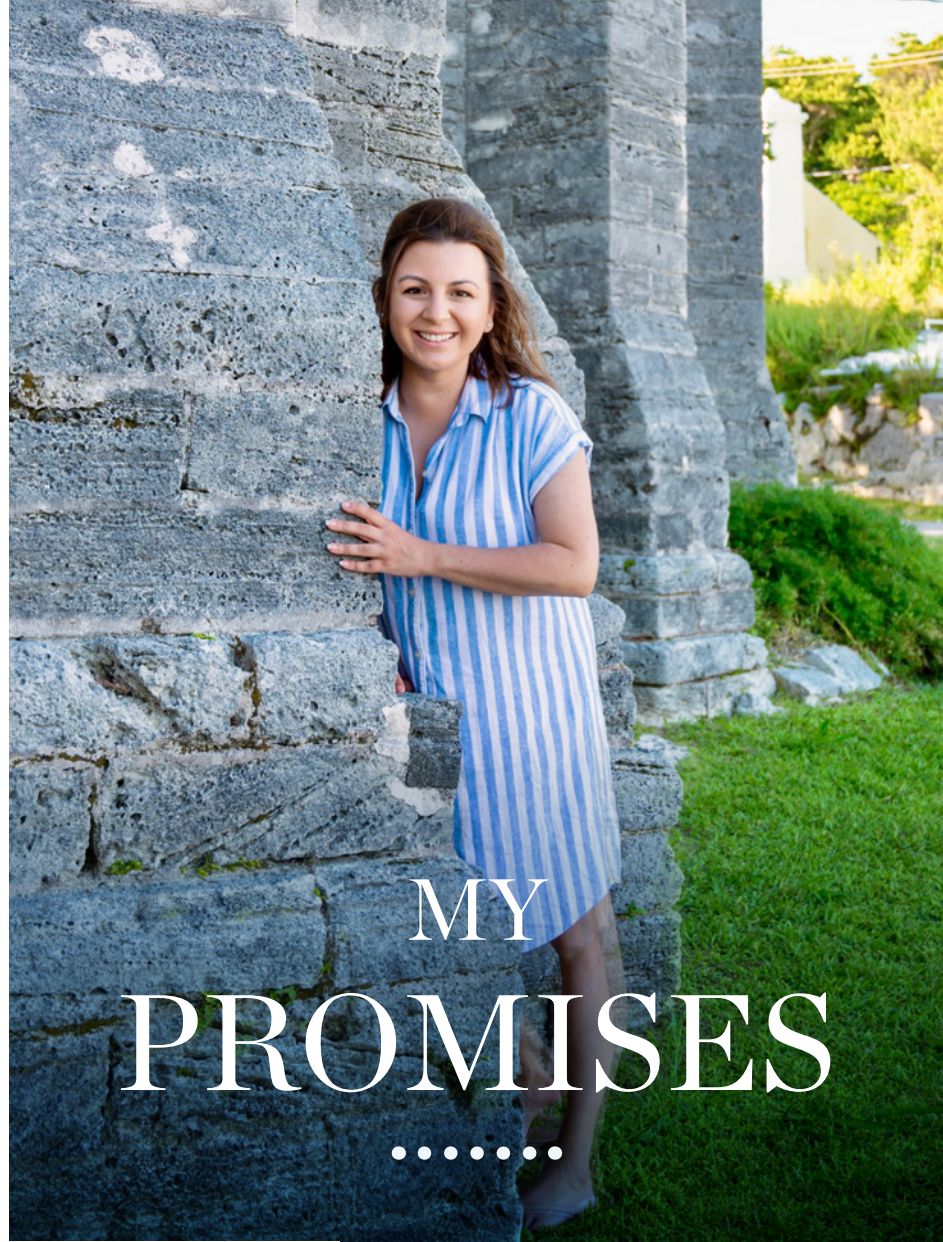
**My group of friends – who have BECOME EXTENDED FAMILY – shares a similar kind of warmth.**

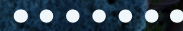
I **PROMISE** that this child will have both roots and wings. She'll know where she came from and that, with determination and hard work, the sky is the limit.
