



She will know her story and learn that the love she feels – and the life she leads – began with you and the brave decision you are making now.






Starting and leading a non-profit wasn't easy, but on nights like this one it was a lot of fun.


My group of friends - who have BECOME EXTENDED FAMILYshares a similar kind of warmth.
