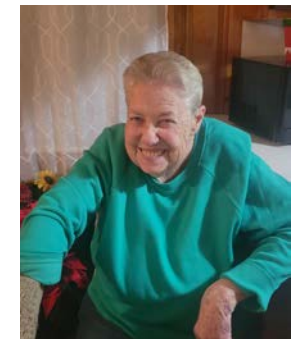
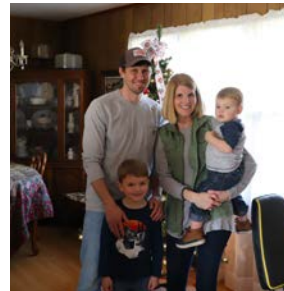
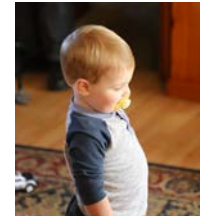

We are located about five miles out of town, and we are lucky to have many parks, trails, waterfalls, rivers and several lakes to visit for swimming, kayaking and camping.

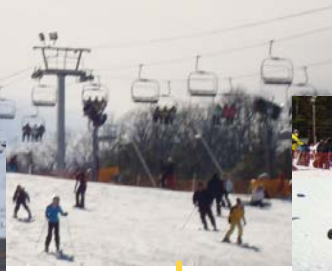
We are close driving distance to many popular places and top ranked children's hospitals. We have top ranked public and private schools with many extra-curricular activities to keep busy.
